



ROLE DESCRIPTION – LIGHTING TECHNICIAN

Reporting to	Senior Technician/ Stage Manager
Responsible for	Operating all aspects of Lighting onboard & any technical/staging support as instructed by the Senior Technician/ Stage Manager
Role Overview	The role of the Lighting Technician is to operate all aspects of the lighting system(s) in various entertainment venues for rehearsals, shows, special events and other activities in order to support in the delivery of the creative product to the required high standards. The role must support the whole technical production team onboard which includes staging requirements and daytime duties as per the rota and Senior Technician/ Stage Manager wishes.

Specific Responsibilities

- Operate lighting for all entertainment areas onboard including; main production shows, rehearsals and second lounge entertainment to provide an excellent standard for passengers
- Maintain and be responsible for the lighting design for each show as per lighting designers setup instruction including basic gobo and colour changes
- Operate lighting for shows from pre-designed production books
- Operate lighting in all other venues including on deck and in secondary lounges
- Under the direction of the Senior Technician, carry out any general technical assistance as required including weekly general cleaning and maintenance of technical equipment
- Assist the Senior Technician/ Stage Manager in undertaking quality control of all technical matters regarding lighting in all entertainment areas
- Under direction of the Senior Technician/ Stage Manager, meet with guest entertainers and certain groups to find out their lighting requirements for upcoming shows and activities
- Ensure the correct usage and storage of technical and staging resources, reporting any faults, damage and/or replacement requirements to the Senior technician/Stage Manager
- Assist with any technical or staging requirements for daytime activities, stage set ups, pack downs etc. as per the rota and senior technicians wishes alongside the other members of the technical team
- Take accountability and accept responsibility for the maintenance and/or any damage to technical equipment and be responsible for reporting this to your superiors
